Eight Contrasts of Christmas

- 1. Jesus endured a **physical** birth to give us a new **spiritual** birth. (*Luke 2:11, John 1:12*)
- 2. Jesus took his place in a **manger** so we might occupy **mansions** in heaven. (*Luke 2:7, John 14:2*)
- 3. Jesus had an earthly **mother** so we might have a heavenly **father**. (Matthew 2:11, Galatians 3:26)
- 4. Jesus became **subject** to others that we might be **free**. (Luke 2:51, Galatians 5:1)
- 5. Jesus **humbled** himself that we might be **exalted**. (*Philippians 2:6-7, Matthew 23:12*)
- 6. Jesus became **poor** so we might be **rich**. (Matthew 8:20, 2 Corinthians 8:9)
- 7. He was hunted by **Herod** that we might be delivered from the grasp of **Satan**. (Matthew 2:13, Hebrews 2:14-15)
- 8. Jesus was welcomed by the **shepsherd** at his birth whereas at our birth we are welcomed by **angels**. (Luke 2:16, Luke 15:10)
