ROMANS 8:1-4

Romans 8:1-4

¹ There is therefore now no condemnation for those who are in Christ Jesus. ² For the law of the Spirit of life has set you free in Christ Jesus from the law of sin and death. ³ For God has done what the law, weakened by the flesh, could not do. By sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh and for sin, he condemned sin in the flesh, ⁴ in order that the righteous requirement of the law might be fulfilled in us, who walk not according to the flesh but according to the Spirit. We are called and commanded to share the good news about Jesus.

Understanding the purpose and place of God's Law in the life of a Christian:

- The purpose of the law is to show us how to be righteous.
- The problem is that because of sin, no one is able to keep the law.

Jesus comes to fulfill the law - not do away with it completely.

- Jesus does not change what the law says, He changes what it says about us.
- Our righteousness is tied to our faith in Jesus not our ability to keep the law.
