TABLES OF GRACE Feeding the 5,000 - *Jesus challenges His disciples*

Mark 6:30-44 - Jesus feeds 5,000

Through this miracle, we see how Jesus challenges His disciples in the work He calls them to.

- Jesus modeled a priority for those who did not know Him yet.
- Jesus often challenges His followers to do or provide more than what might seem reasonable or available.
- Most often, everything necessary for the work Jesus is calling us to is already available in the context we are sent to.

GOD'S WORD FOR TODAY

2 Kings 4:42-44

⁴² A man came from Baal-shalishah, bringing the man of God bread of the firstfruits, twenty loaves of barley and fresh ears of grain in his sack. And Elisha said, "Give to the men, that they may eat." ⁴³ But his servant said, "How can I set this before a hundred men?" So he repeated, "Give them to the men, that they may eat, for thus says the Lord, 'They shall eat and have some left." ⁴⁴ So he set it before them. And they ate and had some left, according to the word of the Lord.

Mark 6:30-44

³⁰ The apostles returned to Jesus and told him all that they had done and taught. 31 And he said to them, "Come away by yourselves to a desolate place and rest a while." For many were coming and going, and they had no leisure even to eat. 32 And they went away in the boat to a desolate place by themselves. 33 Now many saw them going and recognized them, and they ran there on foot from all the towns and got there ahead of them. 34 When he went ashore he saw a great crowd, and he had compassion on them, because they were like sheep without shepherd. And he began to teach them many things. 35 And when it grew late, his disciples came to him and said, "This is a desolate place, and the hour is now late. ³⁶ Send them away to go into the surrounding countryside and villages and buy themselves something to eat." 37 But he answered them, "You give them something to eat." And they said to him, "Shall we go and buy two hundred denarii worth of bread and give it to them to eat?" 38 And he said to them, "How many loaves do you have? Go and see." And when they had found out, they said, "Five, and two fish." 39 Then he commanded them all to sit down in groups on the green grass. 40 So they sat down in groups, by hundreds and by fifties. 41 And taking the five loaves and the two fish, he looked up to heaven and said a blessing and broke the loaves and gave them to the disciples to set before the people. And he divided the two fish among them all. 42 And they all ate and were satisfied. ⁴³ And they took up twelve baskets full of broken pieces and of the fish. 44 And those who ate the loaves were five thousand men.
